- D **Literary and other adaptations (including drama, dance, poetry, adapted for young adults, etc.)**



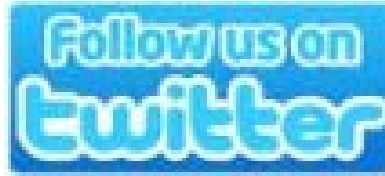

Dos and Don'ts

- Do:**
- ❖ Have fun!
 - ❖ Question everything: We all have a lot to learn about RDA outside MARC (the FRBR/RDA model)
 - ❖ Think about Relationships (suggest new designators, etc.)



Jane advises:
Don't panic!

- Don't:**
- ❖ Think about MARC
 - ❖ Get hung up on descriptive stuff (punctuation, abbreviations, etc.)



More Dos and Don'ts

- Don't:**
- ❖ Apply 'provider-neutral' guidelines
 - ❖ Add ISBNs that do not match your manifestation for the resource



Jane advises:
Don't panic!

- Do:**
- ❖ Make a new entity record whenever anything does not match your resource
 - ❖ Provide all attributes that might be important for differentiation, identification or selection
 - ❖ Have fun!



Yet more Dos and Don'ts

- Do:**
- ❖ Check MARC mapping carefully, and suggest improvements
 - ❖ Add relationships to JaneBase records
 - ❖ Have fun!



Jane advises:
Don't panic!

- Don't:**
- ❖ Just do core: think about what will be important for differentiation, identification and/or selection
 - ❖ Edit JaneBase descriptive attributes (RIMMF Identifier prefix: 'janebase')
